**Re: CLOSING OF PADDLE TENNIS COURT**

Dear Members of the Lakeshore Community Association:

The Board is in receipt of a REVISED June 29, 2020 Los Angeles County Health Department order regarding Covid-19 and Tennis and Pickleball Courts. The revised order requires additional and significantly more stringent protocols than the original May 13, 2020 order, which was the basis for opening up the court at that time.

During an executive meeting held yesterday, the Board evaluated how our Paddle Tennis Court would have to be operated in order to comply with all the restrictions and also consulted with legal counsel. As the Board did when considering the pools reopening, they carefully considered all of the risks and associated cost to the Association should the paddle tennis court remain open at this time.

**In the final analysis, the Board has made the difficult determination to close our paddle tennis court effective immediately until the restrictions have been loosened.**

The major factors considered include: the onerous County Order requirements and associated expenses to remain open and the associated liability and risk issues of remaining open.
