WLMA REPORT

The Alum Sulphate first treatment that was supposed to start on April 3-7 was rescheduled and applied on Tuesday April 11 through Friday April 14 and already the lake is showing clarity. The second treatment will either be applied in the Fall of this year or next Spring. The reason is that the tremendous amount of rain received, and the lake turnover caused the alkalinity of the water to decline drastically. Lake Management will continue to give updates as to when the second treatment will be applied.

More good newsover 400 Carp have been captured in the last 6 weeks! March and April are the most critical times to electroshock Carp as this is the timeframe they spawn. Most of the recent catches have been around the docks.

Lake Management has actively been replacing old and faded boat registration stickers with new reflective ones which will last longer and can been seen at night easily by the Lake Patrol.
