PREPAREDNESS MONTH!

Get an emergency kit, make a plan, be informed and get involved. Visit https://www.ready.gov/september for more information. Here are some necessary items:

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation.
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food.
- Battery powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries.
- Flashlight and extra batteries.
- First Aid Kit including required medications.
- Dusk mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place.
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties.
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities.
- Can opener for food.
- Local maps.
- Food and necessary supplies for your pets.

For Communities:

Find out what kinds of disasters, both natural and man-made, are most likely to occur in your area and how you will be notified. Contact a nearby Citizen Corps Council for help with emergency planning, or work with your local government and emergency management office to help start a Council in your area. ILLEGAL FISHING

Only Lakeshore residents and guests with a valid State fishing license and Westlake Fishing Badge are permitted to fish in the lake from Lakeshore property and no fishing is allowed from the docks. RESIDENTS-If you have guests (this includes relatives, kids, etc) that come to visit, you MUST accompany them should they wish to fish. If you see anyone fishing from the docks or who is not permitted to fish from Lakeshore property, you can call the Westlake Lake Patrol at (818) 889-5377 and report the illegal fishing and the Lake Patrol will come to where the illegal fishing is occurring and address the matter.
